### Outline of Coverages of the Family Accidental Death Policy & Beneficiary Designation

Included with membership, the Farm Bureau Life Insurance Company agrees to insure each individual county Farm Bureau member participating in the Wisconsin Farm Bureau Blanket Accidental Death Policy.

The plan covers any accident, independent of all other causes, which results in the death of an insured within 90 days from the date of the accident. However, it does not cover an accident on a public road or highway occurring or arising out of occupancy or use of a vehicle that is required to be licensed by the department of motor vehicles.

Under the policy provisions, the Company will pay the Member \$1,500; the Member's spouse \$1,500; and Member's eligible children \$500. An additional \$200 is added to the member's or the spouse's benefit payment for each full year a Farm Bureau membership is continuously maintained. The maximum payment is \$3,500. If the membership lapses all benefits will terminate.

A member's spouse and children are covered as long as membership status is maintained. Children are covered until the child is 21, provided the child is not married and is a full-time student and dependent upon the member.
